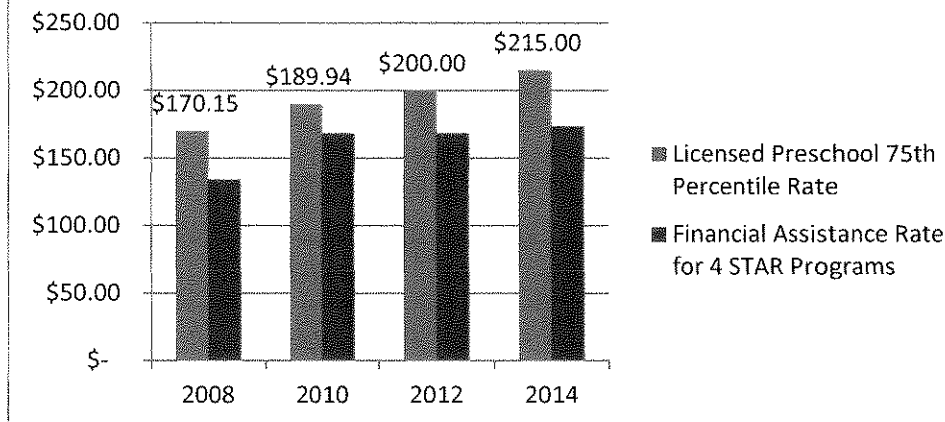


## Comparison of 2014 Market Rates to the Current State Preschool 4 STAR Rate

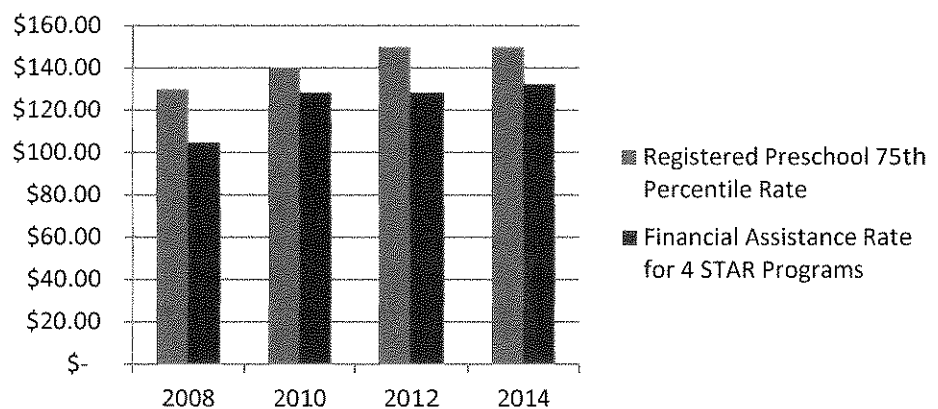
### Licensed Child Care Rate Comparison 75th Percentile to 4 STAR Rate



From 2008 to 2014 the market rates for a preschool age child in licensed child care center increased from \$170.15 per week to \$215.00 per week (26.4%). The current state preschool base rate is at the 7.14 percentile of the 2014 market rate, while the 2012 state 4 STAR rate is at the 35.99 percentile.

From 2008 to 2014 the market rates for a preschool age child in registered home care increased from \$130.00 to \$150 (15.4%); The current state preschool base rate is at the 3.71 percentile of the 2014 market rate, while the state 4 STAR rate is at the 42.5 percentile.

## 2014 Market Rate Survey

The 2014 market rate survey was completed using information from October 2014. The survey indicates an overall increase of rates charged to families across provider types. Licensed program rates increased an average of 4% from 2010, while registered home programs increased an average of 3%.
